Major Duties & Responsibilities

Trainee will be trained to: Climb 30 foot poles to install secondary service lines; climb 40 to 45 foot poles to install primary and single phase and 3-phase transformers; pull, install and splice 15 KV cables for underground services; dig 6 to 8 feet holes to erect power poles; install residential and commercial meters; inspect and recommend appropriate action to customers regarding ground rods, meter sockets wiring and panels meter location, etc; assist/recommend appropriate action to Inspectors regarding pole transformers, insulators; carry out Preventative Maintenance [PM] work; operate bucket and boom trucks; calibrate electric meters; pull lines, hookup transformers and work on hot line on power poles; prepare written reports for work performed; job order status, power outages, new installations, etc.; gather and prepare tools, equipment and materials to perform assigned daily tasks; enforce safety practices and other duties as assigned.

Minimum Requirements

<i>Education</i>	High school diploma or GED.
<i>Experience</i>	Prefer experience in electrical wiring, mechanical skills (using hand tools) and some training in lineman work; first-aid and other lifesaving training; must have a valid driver's license.
<i>Knowledge, Skills & Abilities</i>	Ability to: Adapt and learn new techniques; read, understand and apply detail instructions; work well under pressure in a fast paced environment; be proactive; be able to complete reports and other paperwork and must be able to perform mathematical calculations. Requires physical strength and personal fitness. Outstanding personality; enjoys working with people; gets things done professionally at reasonable costs.
<i>Physical Demands</i>	Work involves standing, walking, stooping, bending, climbing and kneeling; Medium to heavy lifting is required. Good physical fitness is a requirement. Candidate will be subject to working under bad/unclear weather conditions in order to complete tasks. Be available to work early hours and/or late hours including weekends, holidays and on shift rotation schedules.
