Major Duties & Responsibilities

The primary objective of the position is to operate heavy equipment including backhoes, wastewater vacuumed trucks, excavators, forklifts at wastewater sewer lines, lift stations, pumps, manholes, and wastewater facilities. Duties include preparing and manipulating heavy equipment to ensure the appropriate movement of materials, and liaising with coworkers to ensure that the projects are completed accurately and safely. The incumbent will be required to conduct his/her duties in a safe and diligent manner at all times.
