Major Duties & Responsibilities

The primary objective of the position is to perform as an assistant electrical maintenance technician in the installation, maintenance and repair of water distribution electrical fixtures, apparatus, circuitry and control equipment; to contribute to safe working conditions at all times; to aid the reliability and efficiency of water activities in sustaining and expanding a reliable water system; to aid the balancing of the hydraulic system in providing clean, safe potable water to every community within the territory of American Samoa. Minimum Requirements

<i>Education</i>	Associate of Arts (AA) or Associate of Science (AS) in Electrical Technology or Electrical Trades Certificate from an accredited Trade or Technical Institution, completed trade certificates or 3 years apprenticeship.
<i>Experience</i>	Combined three (3) years of minimum utility / industrial electrical experience. Repairing and installation of pumps and other equipment for Water system will be an added advantage

<i>Knowledge, Skills & Abilities</i>	Required knowledge: Electrical principles, materials, tools & equipment used in the electrical industry and related mathematics; safety principles, methods & practices.
