Major Duties & Responsibilities

The primary objective of the position is to perform manual duties on a daily basis, assist with solid waste, electricity (generation and distribution), and water maintenance services as assigned; help maintain and enforce zero tolerance of littering; promote safe work practices and in accordance with established safety standards. Perform other duties assigned and given from time to time by Supervisor.

<i>Experience</i>	Two (2) years related work experience.
<i>Knowledge, Skills & Abilities</i>	For general maintenance; ability to use water and solid waste tools and equipment; know, understand and carry out oral and written instructions in both English and Samoan; be dedicated, trustworthy, punctual and hard working. Know & understand the importance of safe work habits; troubleshoot maintenance problems, fix and/or schedule and follow-up on repairs; able to order and maintain parts, tools and equipment used in daily assignments; work with minimal supervision.
<i>Physical Demands</i>	Work involves standing, walking, stooping, bending, climbing and kneeling; involves occasional lifting of up to 70 pounds, must therefore have good physical fitness. Candidate must be willing and able to work during inclement weather conditions. Must be available to work early and/or late hours, weekends, holidays and on shift rotation schedules. It is mandatory for candidate to reside in Tau.
